The Asset Standards Authority (ASA) is an independent unit established within Transport for NSW, and is the network design and standards authority for NSW rail assets. To remain fully independent, a new office location and fitout was required for ASA.

IDPM was engaged to oversee the delivery of the new fitout within the framework of the Transport Projects procurement and probity guidelines.

A select tendering method was adopted whereby government-approved Head Contractors were selected to submit a bid based on the requirements and a formal assessment process undertaken.

The design features timber batten screens and ceilings, open plan workspace with collaborative project tables and feature lighting, operable walls and meeting rooms with audio visual interactivity.

Additionally, we utilised the existing facilities and part of the built environment as a cost saving opportunity for Transport for NSW.

The project was successfully planned and structured and delivered on time and within budget for ASA.
